Nomination

Seoul National University invites AEARU member institutions to nominate one (1) student from your institution to participate by December 10th, 2019.

Nomination process

1. Select and nominate one (1) student by the deadline
2. Submit the nomination form to international@snu.ac.kr no later than December 10, 2019
3. Nominated student will automatically be waived of application fee
4. SNU will directly contact and inform the student of acceptance
5. Student needs to pay travel costs to and from Seoul National University

Costs

- Meals, Local transportation fee: Waived
- Accommodation (for five nights): Waived
- Travel Costs: Participants are responsible for funding their travel costs (including airfare) to and from Seoul National University.
- Equipment (ski, boots, helmet) rental fee: Waived
- Ski suit rental fee: Participants must bring their own ski suits and socks
** Ski suit rental at Phoenix Hotels & Resorts is available at around USD 100*
