I. INTRODUCTORY REMARKS BY THE CHAIRPERSON

A. Workshop Participation

Chairperson CHUNG called the 5th Board of Directors' Meeting to order at 3:25 p.m. He noted that many workshops were planned for the year 2000, with some members bearing more active roles than others in volunteering for the next workshops. Discussion followed how best to increase participation. The conclusion was to encourage all members to be more active.

2. It was noted that Nanjing University could be more active than it has been. It was suggested that AEARU send all members the table showing how active each has been. Thus the inactive members would notice what they have been missing.

B. <u>Members Attendance at Annual General Meetings</u>

- 3. Chair CHUNG commented that it was unusual for the Chinese Mainland not to come to the Annual General Meeting, nor send a representative, as did Fudan University and Tsinghua University-Beijing.
- 4. President CHEN informed the Board that a visa problem was not what prevented them or representatives from coming to the Annual General Meeting. It was offered as a possible explanation that university from the Chinese Mainland, presidents' foreign trips might be limited in numbers.
- 5. President WOO suggested that perhaps the Chair send a letter to Tsinghua University-Beijing, Fudan University and Seoul National University stating that the AEARU meeting was scheduled so far ahead of time, that it should have had precedence over other meetings.
